At Seghesio Family Vineyards, the story starts in 1895, when an Italian immigrant and his new wife planted Zinfandel vines deep in Dry Creek Valley soil, setting down roots that are still growing, five generations and 125 vintages later. Generations of Seghesios have nourished and cared for their vineyards, persevering through Prohibition, earthquakes, fires and droughts.

Why Zinfandel? They like to say that Zinfandel is not for the faint of heart – it may be easy to drink but it is a challenging variety to grow. Luckily, they aren't ones to turn their backs on a challenge! Though Zinfandel's popularity may have waxed and waned, at Seghesio they believe in Zinfandel's capacity to make fascinating wines that are bold, complex, age-worthy, and have something to say.

While "Old Vine" may be an unregulated term, they have devised their own strict guidelines for using the phrase. For Seghesio, "Old Vine" indicates a minimum age of 50 years, but they exceed their own guidelines! Their Old Vine Zinfandel, for example, is produced from vineyards with an average age closer to 75 years.

Their commitment to sustainable farming and cultivating old vine vineyards stems from their belief in the capacity of these vines to make truly extraordinary wines with incredible concentration, complexity, and intrigue. Seghesio Zinfandel, 2023/24, Sonoma County



The nose bursts with vibrant raspberry, accented by the rich aroma of plum and the deep, juicy undertones of blackberries. On the palate, lively acidity dances gracefully, creating an engaging, tactile experience that glides seamlessly into a finish of silky, supple tannins.

A vibrant medley of pear, lime leaf, and lime zest opens on the nose, complemented by delicate notes of lemon peel, lemongrass, and orange blossom. The palate is bright and juicy, with hints of lychee and fresh citrus adding complexity.
